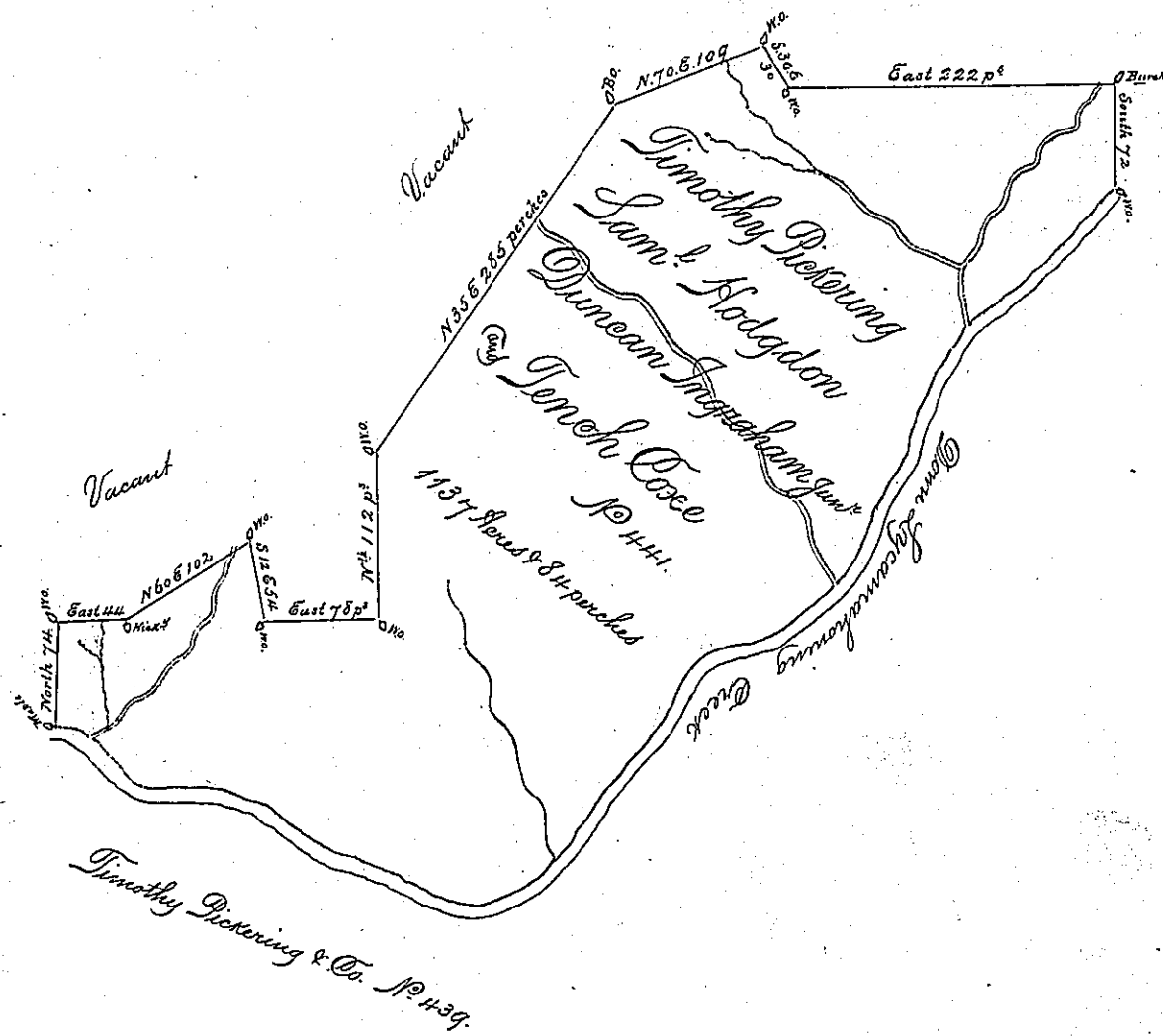

Containing One thousand one hundred and thirty seven Acres and eighty four perches with the usual Allowances of six pt. Cent for Roads &c^o Surveyed for Timothy Pickering, Saml. Hodgdon, Duncan Ingraham Junr and Tench Coxe the 1st Day of June 1786. In pursuance of a Warrant Dated May 17th 1785. No 441.
