William Rippey in the Township formerly Lurgan in the County of Cumberland - N° 1. containing Seventy six Acres & 143 Perches and the usual Allowance &c. Survey'd in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Rippey June 3^d 1762 - N° 2. contains thirty Acres & Allowance Survey'd in pursuance of a Warrant to Samuel Rippey Dated March 26^d 1767 - N° 3. contains twenty five Acres and Allowance Survey'd in pursuance of an Order of Survey - obliterated - November 3^d 1766 - N° 1777 - N° 4. contains one hundred and forty eight Acres and 151 Perches & Allowance Survey'd in pursuance of a Warrant to Daniel Duncan Dated May 23^d 1763 - Containing in the whole two hundred and eighty Acres & three quarters & Allowance Survey'd for W^m Rippey
