Surveyed the above described pieces of Land for John Robinson, April 24<sup>th</sup> 1821

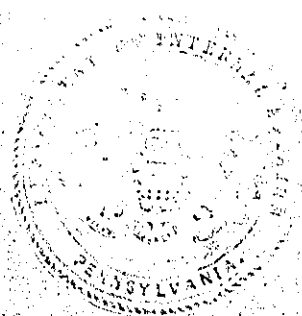
