Note. When I made a Survey for John Barclay in the year 1754, a Vacancy was left at 2. on the above Draught. Perhaps 12^{acres} or 15^{acres} which Hugh Barclay proposed to take, but did not apply for a warrant for that purpose during his life that I know of, or ~~or~~ therefore lays yet, for his successors to apply for if they do it in time.
