



Agreeably to the Order of the Board of Property Dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May 1792. It appears amongst my papers received from William Kersey that he had Executed the same, and left Documents on which I founded the above Diagram which I have done as carefully as I was able at the Request of Peter Dinkle. A. B. C. D. represents the lines on which the Half Perch mentioned in the Order is laid off. It appears to be the Part which receives the addition of half a perch from D to A. The part where the letter R is placid appears to be an appendage for Illustration.
