Resurveyed the above described part for George Zerr and John Geiger on the 10th day of September 1865 Containing Thirty acres & Ninety perches and the allowance of Sixty seven 30 acres & allowance being part of the survey on Warrant to Owen Hugh and 90 perches & the allowance being part of the Survey on Warrant to Mary Hugh
