Proprietor &c. bearing date the 30th day of October 1736 which License is for four hundred and fifty Acres, two hundred acres part whereof was released by Tobias Fry in his Life Time to Baltzer Spangler two Hundred and fifty acres residue thereof covers that Quantity of this Draught the Right whereof is now vested in Godfrid Fry the forty seven Acres Residue of the Land contained in this Draught Godfrid Fry does not chuse to have cut off but desires to purchase of the Honourable the Proprietaries.
