



A Draught of a Tract of Land situated in Manchester Township in the County of York late part of the County of Lancaster containing Four Hundred and ^{fourty eight} ~~forty~~ Acres and ¹⁴⁵ ~~140~~ Perches and the allowance of Six Acres p. Cent for Roads and Highways first surveyed the 8th day of October 1746 by Thomas Cookson Esq. late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County afterwards the 7th day of April 1752 by a certain William Brown in pursuance of two Warrants ^{granted to John White} the one bearing Date the 21st day of August 1744 the other bearing Date the 6th day of October 1748. The Lines examined protracted, calculated & divided agreeable to his share and the Overplus cut off the 7th day of September 1753 at the Request of Nicholas Warrman
