



A Draught of a Piece of Land Situate in Lower Chanceford Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 340^a 45 pps and allowances of Land, which was Originally Surveyed on the 25th day of May 1798, by John Forsyth the late D.S. for John Smith in Pursuance of a warrant Granted to said John Smith, bearing date at Philadelphia the 1st day of January 1787, and then Surveyed, in Pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated the 3rd day of April 1797, and then 356^a were returned into the Surveyor Generals Office &c by John Forsyth the D.S. &c Now at the Request of Rebecca Lusk the present owner of a Part of the whole tract, I have Resurveyed the above according to the Old lines. On the 22nd day of February A.D. 1833, Mrs. says she has not her full quantity of Land, and according to my Survey & calculation I have found it to Contain 340^a 45 ps as above set forth. the said Rebecca Lusk requested me to make Return hereof &c
