Hugh Alafander conveyed to William Alafander who also Bought from John Burd and whose Administrator Knop Alafander conveyed to John Foot the present owner.

N^o 2 represented by the broken lines is a draft of A tract of Land surveyed for James Murvey in pursuance of A Warrant dated the 6th day of November 1786. This tract interferes Three Acres and Ninety seven perches with the John Burd survey. James Murvey conveyed to John Burd who conveyed to Dr David Wishard the Present owner.
