



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Little Britain Township in the County of Lancaster containing two hundred and Eighty three Acres and twenty nine ps<sup>s</sup> & the usual allowance of Six ps Cent for roads & 231<sup>as & ps</sup> = 70<sup>ps</sup> & the usual allowance being a part of 249 = 732 & the allowance surveyed in pursuance of three Warrants dated the 30<sup>th</sup> of May A.D. 1752 Granted unto William Naugh & fifty one acres and one hundred and nineteen perches and the usual allowance was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant - - dated the 17<sup>th</sup> of March A.D. 1746 Granted unto Thomas Berry Surveyed the above Tract of Land the 21<sup>st</sup> of October 1809 for Robert Pennell
