



The above is a Tract of Land Situate in the Township of Rockhill in the County of Bucks & State of Pennsylvania Containing Three Hundred and forty two Acres and One Hundred and forty eight perches and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. (being part of a Tract of Seven Hundred & eighty acres of land that was formerly Survey'd for Dietrick Melick in pursuance of a General Grant obtained by him from the Honorable Proprietaries of this Province about the Year 1751. and was afterwards resurvey'd to him by Virtue of a Warrant of resurvey Dated the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1768) Now belonging to Abraham Hambold, who purchased it at different times, of different persons, as will appear by the Deed polls, and other Conveyances in the possession of said Abraham Hambold. Shewing a regular Chain of Title from the Warrantee to the present time.
