We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahela, Yohogara and Ohio do hereby Certify that Robert Taylor assignee of James Clemans is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land on the Waters of Buffalo Creek in the County of Ohio to include his settlement made in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and seventy four.

Given under our hands at Redstone old Fort this Twenty second day of November 1779 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
