 west 107 p<sup>ts</sup> to Hickory thence north 79 Degrees west 111 p<sup>ts</sup> to White oak thence south 60 Degrees west to the  
 place of Beginning Containing three hundred <sup>thirty one</sup> & eighteen acres 96 p<sup>ts</sup> and the allowance of six acres  
 p<sup>ts</sup> Cent for high ways & Roads Surveyed p<sup>ts</sup>
