Surveyed March 6<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> 1853 to Jonathan S. Agey the above described tracts of Land situated in White Township, Indiana County containing three hundred and four acres and one hundred and twenty eight perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c the above being composed of four separate surveys as follows viz: letter A is a part of a survey made to Phillip Walters on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 1789. By Warrant of the 9<sup>th</sup> of March 1787 letter B is Eighty acres or part of a survey made to Thomas Allison By Warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of September 1825 letter C is a survey made to Peter Rickart on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1837 By Warrant dated 10<sup>th</sup> of May 1837 which includes or covers the greater part of the Phillip Walters or first named survey letter D is a survey made to the said Jonathan S. Agey on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1849 By Warrant dated 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 1849 Bound as above described
