



The above is a Draught of a tract of Land situate on the Waters of Buffaloe Creek, Cal^d Point Pleasant Containing four hundred and two Acres Surveyed February the 3rd 1786 In pursuance of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners of the State of Virginia to Joseph Alexander in the following Words.

We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahalia, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Joseph Alexander Assignee of Mathias Alt. is intitled to four hundred acres of land in the County of Ohio situate on the Waters of Buffaloe Creek to include his settlement made in the year 1774 also a right in preemption to one thousand Acres adjoining thereto

Given under our hands at Coys fort the eleventh day of February 1780 & in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
