



In pursuance of a Warrant to William Hill dated the 17th of June 1805, and a decree of the Board of property of the 3^d of Sept^r 1810, and the order of the Surveyor General thereon founded to me directed, Surveyed on the 12th July 1813 the above described tract of land, containing three hundred and ninety nine acres, one hundred and fifty nine perches, and allowance of 6 p^{er} C^t. Situate in Mipenose Township Lycoming County, and bounded as above described. There is a small House on the above tract with a family residing therein, a small stable and about ten acres of land cleared.

The part marked A appears to have been Surveyed to Grace Little in pursuance of application N^o 196 dated the 3^d day of April 1769.
