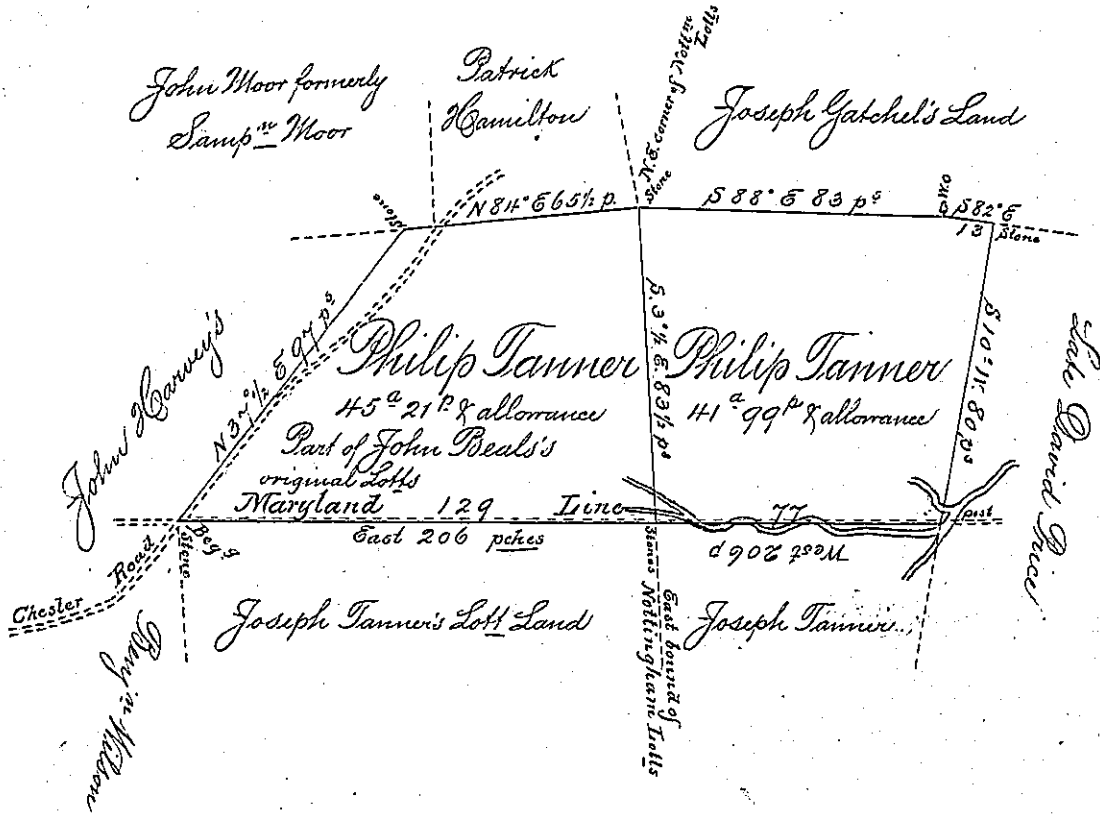

The above Draught describes two Parcels of Land belonging to Philip Tanner situated near Little Elk in East Nottingham Township Chester County called Mount-Rocky viz<sup>t</sup> 45 acres & 21 pches & allowance is the North East Part of the Lott No 36 originally surveyed for John Beals in the year 1702 & Resurveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> Mo (April) 1788 In pursuance of a Warrant to me directed bearing date the 29<sup>th</sup> of November 1787 - - And 41<sup>a</sup> 99 pches is the Northern Part of a Tract formerly surveyed for Robert Naly adjoining the East side of said Beals's Lott by Warrant bearing date the 23<sup>rd</sup> of May 1741.
