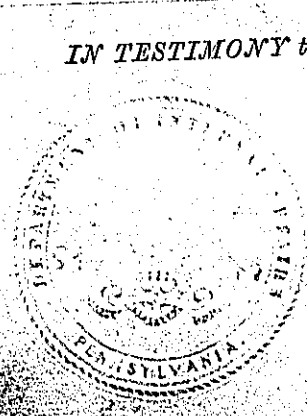


Courses and distances down the River beginning at a post here an ash stood  
 N 37° W 39 poles  
 N 22° W 49 do  
 N 27° W 18 crest  
 N 12° E 32 1/2  
 N 22 1/2 E 34 to a stake  
 222 1/2 adjoining Mrs. Stewart's grant.

The above was surveyed in pursuance of an order from the board of property dated April 23<sup>d</sup> 1810 in the name of Alexander McKee on application No. 17 dated Feb<sup>y</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> 1769 on a special order — and now contains by the reservoir seven hundred twenty eight acres eighty perches & 3/10<sup>th</sup> allowance of six p<sup>er</sup>ches surveyed by Robert Beatty D.S. 10 & 11 days of April 1823, and entered and returned by —
