



The Draught of a Tract of Land Called Valley plain situate on the Waters of Mahanoy Creek, and about 13 Miles N. E. from the River Susquehanna in Upper Mahanoy Township in the County of Northumberland (formerly Called Berks County) Adjoining Lands of Philip Mowrer Jesse Yearnall, and others; Containing two hundred and sixty nine Acres, and twenty perches & 7/10 of a perch with the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c (It being a very old survey, by whom it was Executed I could not learn). And resurveyed by me agreeable to the old Lines on the 26th Day of August 1811. unto Alexander Klinger by virtue of his Application Dated October 21st 1764 (No 2900)
