David 106 pches to a Black Oak thence E. by N. by Vacant Land 160 p^{ts} to a Black Oak thence S. by East ^{one hundred & six p^{ts}} to a Black Oak thence W. by South along a Barren Hill 160 p^{ts} to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred acres and the usual allowance for Roads.
