It is part of a tract of Land Originally Surveyed for John Adam by virtue of a warrant Dated the 27th Day of February 1733, Containing Fifty Two acres and 94 perches and the allowance. It is the larger part of a tract of Land Originally Surveyed for Philip Hartman by virtue of a warrant Dated the 9th Day of April 1741 Containing Ninety acres and 81 perches and the allowance. The Two above described Tracts of Land Containing in the whole one hundred and forty three acres and 15 perches and the allowance of six p Cent.
