We the Comm<sup>rs</sup> for adjusting claims to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, York<sup>a</sup> & Ohio do hereby Certify that James Nelson is Entitled to four Hundred acres of Land in Ohio County laying on the waters of Buffalo to include his actual settlement made in the Year of Our Lord one thousand seven Hundred & seventy six. Given under our hands at Redstone old fort the 21<sup>st</sup> day of Decem<sup>r</sup> 1779 in the 4<sup>th</sup> Year of the Commonwealth.
