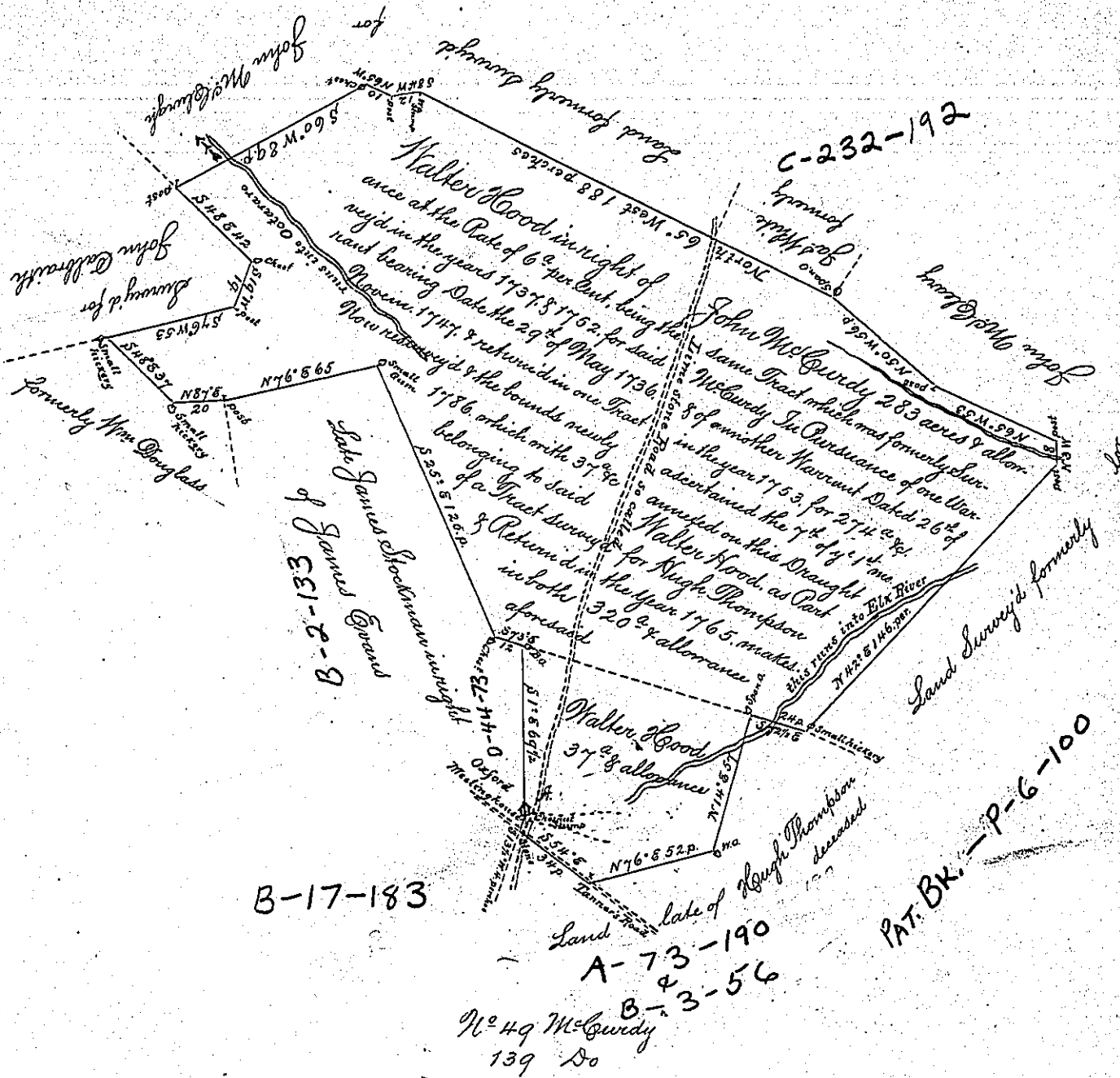

This appears to be an accurate Description of the Land held by said Walker Hood closing very nearly by the Courses of the Resurvey Certified this 9th of the 1st mo. 1786.
