We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Zaddock Springer is Entitled to four Hundred Acres of Land in the County of Monongalia on the Waters of Georges Creek to Include his actual Settlement made in the Year One Thousand seven hundred and Seventy three - Given under our hands at Coxes Fort the twenty sixth Day of February 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
