



The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the Road leading from Redstone ferry to Washington Town in Washington County called Drakes Choice Surveyed Jan'y 21st 1785 (for Peter Drake Containing 333 1/4 acres) in pursuance of a Certificate of which the following is a Copy

We the Commissioners appointed to adjust the Claims to unpatented Lands in Counties of Monongahela Yohogany & Ohio do hereby Certify that Peter Drake is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Monongahela on the Waters of Ten Mile Creek to include his Settlement made in the year One thousand and seventy two also a right in preemption to One thousand acres adjoining thereto

Given under our hands at Coxes Fort the 18th day of February 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
