



Situate in Fawn Township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 331^{as} & 158 perches and Allowance of Six per Cent. &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 1037^{as} and allowance of Land. Which was Originally Surveyed by John Churchman on the 1st day of the 9th month 1744. In Pursuance of Three Warrants Granted to Alexander McCannell one for 500^{as} dated the 11th day of May A.D. 1744. The 2nd dated the 6th day of June 1749 for 100^{as} & the 3rd for 250^{as} dated the 25th day of September A.D. 1746. And afterwards Resurveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 3rd & 4th days of the 11th month 1768 and several pieces of vacant land added. In pursuance of a warrant of Resurvey dated March 5th A.D. 1768. Granted to James, Alexander & William McCannell said to Contain by the resurvey 1058^{as} & 90 perches & allowance. The above Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 22nd day of August Anno Domini 1810 at the request the owner John Meeper who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation
