



Situate on the Stony fork of Sandy Creek in Wharton Township, Fayette County and  
 Surveyed the 21-23<sup>d</sup> May 1835 In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Paul Roe for 400  
 acres dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February 1794 - there is three small improvements amounting to  
 about 50 acres in all - three families are living on it, and the first improvement is about 30 years old
