



A Draught of a Piece of Land situate in Godorus Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth 64^{1/2} & 90 perches & allowances & part of 274^{1/2} & allowances & which was originally surveyed on the 22^d day of October 1751 by George Stevenson late D. S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 150^{ac} granted to Peter Bingle, bearing date the 10th day of September 1750. Since divided & now on the 20th day of June A.D. 1837 Examined & Corrected the above & at the request of Jacob Hershey the present owner who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation per D. Lees D. S.
