



A Draught of a Piece of Land Situate in Codorus Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth 53<sup>as</sup> & 31 Perches and allowance & part of 27 1/2<sup>ac</sup> & allowance &c. which was Originally Surveyed on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of October 1751 by George Stevenson late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 150<sup>ac</sup> granted to Peter Bingle bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September 1750. Since divided and now on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1837 Resurveyed & Calculated the above &c. for Daniel Leese, Esq.
