Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson late Del on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of October 1752 and recently by John Forsyth late Del on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of December 1788 in pursuance of a Warrant for 150<sup>ac</sup> granted to Daniel Heckintorn bearing date the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December 1751.

Resurveyed by the old settled lines of the present adjoining and excluding all the interfering claims on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of January 1821 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property granted to Philip Gentzler bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 1821 instant.
