



A draught of a Tract of land the property of Robert Maxwell Esq. formerly supposed to lay in Little Britain Township, Cecil County & State of Maryland, but has since been discovered to be in Little Britain Township Lancaster and State of Pennsylvania. Containing three hundred and sixty five acres and the usual allowance of six p. Cent for roads &c. having formerly been held by Maryland patents or Rights composed of several different surveys, but from the inaccuracy of the said surveys, it is impossible to represent them on the above draught.
