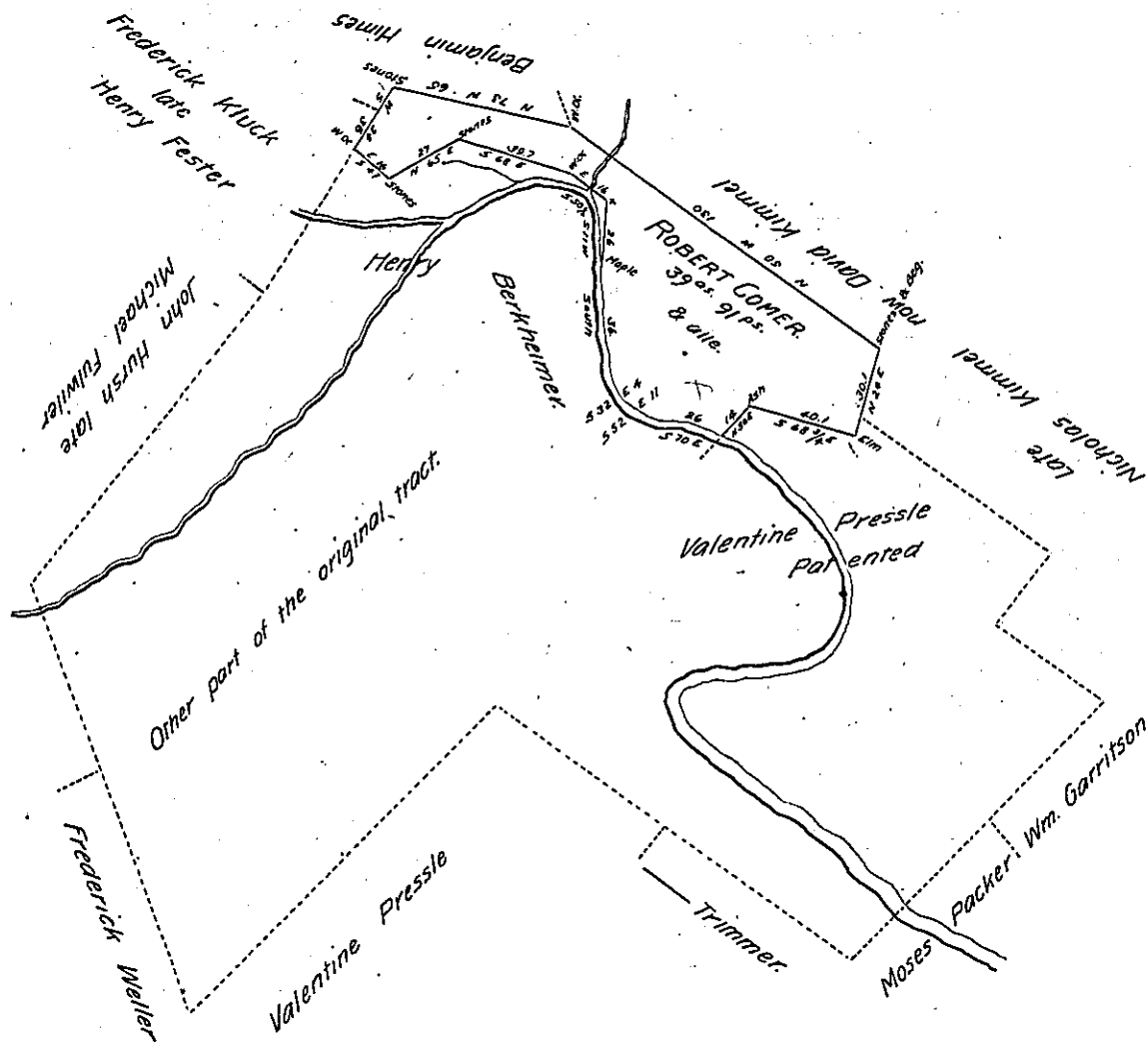

Situate in Washington (late Warrington) Township York County - Containing as above set forth thirty nine acres ninety one perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &ca. - Being part of a larger tract of  $470\frac{1}{2}$  ac & allowance Originally surveyed by John Forsyth Esq<sup>r</sup> late D.S. in pursuance of two Warrants granted to Robert Cromer dated respectively the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1742 & 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1746. The above part resurveyed and divided off the said larger tract at the request of Isaac Thomas who desires the same to be returned for confirmation
