



Situate in Henry Clay township Fayette County & Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> days of November 1835. In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of George Bell for 400<sup>as</sup> dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February 1794. There is about 100<sup>as</sup> cleared, three dwelling houses, barns, &c. and has been settled about 30 years.
