



By Virtue of the Proprietaries Warrant Granted for all the Islands in the Rivers Delaware, Schuylkill, and Susquehanna dated the 13th day of October 1760 and on the application of Jonathan Coates dated October the 5th 1767, The above described Two Islands were Surveyed the 10th day of the Tenth month of the same year. Situate in the River Schuylkill opposite the Land of the said Jonathan Coates and the Mouth of French Creek in Chester County, the one containing Two acres and sixty perches and the other containing one hundred and thirty two square perches of Land beside the allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
