



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Corner situate on the South West side of the Raystown Branch of Juniata, said to be about 5 or 6 Miles above the mouth of said Branch; a small distance below Anthony White's Land, and a small distance above Land Surveyed to John Livingston and on the opposite side of the River from both the said tracts containing sixty one acres and the usual allowance of six of Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 10th Day of June 1771 for John Cuninghame in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him the 13th Day of December 1770
