



Situate in Paradise Township York County Containing as above set forth five acres ninety six perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c<sup>e</sup> Being part of a larger tract of 293½ acres & allowance, Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1753 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Killian Fissel for —as dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1753. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract, on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1791 and now at the request of Conrad Fissel the present owner of said part, the Draught is examined, corrected and returned for Confirmation. February 4<sup>th</sup> 1822.
