



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Sept^r 11th 1828 for James Brown, situate on the waters of Wheeling Creek in Donegall Town-
ship W. C. Containing sixty one Acres and 113 perches & Allowance of six per Cent for highways.

The whole tract was an original survey made Feby 9th 1786 in pursuance of a Virginia Certificate in the name of Stephen Bennet for 265 1/2
Acres of land. The Compartment marked A is owned by John C. Irwin for which he lately obtained a Patent. The Compartment marked B is owned by
the heirs of Thomas McNeal and is yet unpatented, and on which they have a Tenant, the land well improved. James Brown resides on his own
part which is now returned as represented by the black lines
