



Situate in Managhan township in the county of York containing as above set forth sixteen acres and one hundred and fifty three perches and the usual allowance of six pr Cent for Roads &c<sup>o</sup> being part of a larger tract of 228<sup>ac</sup> 112<sup>pr</sup> and allowance of land originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D. S. on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1769 in pursuance of the Application of James Coulter for 200<sup>ac</sup> No 4175 dated 13<sup>th</sup> July 1767. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August 1817 and now at the request of Joseph Bower the present owner of the said part the same is returned for confirmation- 19<sup>th</sup> March 1822
