

The above is a Draught of a Survey made June 18-1785 for Robert Henderson Assignce of Samuel Irwin Assignce of Andrew Neigh in pursuance of a Certificate granted Andrew Neigh in the following words We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahalia Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Andrew Neigh is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in in Yohogania County on the waters of Monongahalia—to include his Settlement made in the Year one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy Seven. Given under our hands at Coxes fort the thirty first day of January 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth

Situate in Notingham Township Washington Gounty on the Waters of Monongahalia Containing 284.
