

Situate in Fairview (late Newbury) township York County containing eighty four acres eighty six perches and allowance of Six pr Cent surveyed pr contract 4th. October 1831 on the Application of John Rankin No.1839 for 50 as dated 8th. November 1766. First surveyed by Thomas Armor 16th. June 1780 as part of the confiscated property of said John Rankin and sold to Alexander Power - see survey in the Secratary of the Commonwealths Office - Note owned and occupied by the heirs of John Bishop deceased. In the above diagram the black lines represent the survey made on John Rankins application—the dotted lines lines edged with blue represent part of a survey of 418 as. & alice. made on Warrant to Abraham Whitmer dated 2nd. Jany. 1788 the dotted lines edged with pink represent part of a Survey of 470 as. & alice. made on Warrant to Eli Lewis dated 15th. August 1785 which two Surveys interfere with said Rankins as above represented.
