

The above described Island Situate in the River Susquahana in the Township of Donegal and Gounty of Lancaster being about forty perches to the westward of Galbraith lower Island directly opposide the Lands of George Vogan on the York Gounty Shore and nearly oppiside the mouth of Canoy Creek on the Lancaster County Shore, Containing Two acres and four perches of Land neat measure, Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrent dated the Thirty first day of August one Thousand eight hundred and seven, Granted Jonathan Hough & William Feree, caled "The lower Snake Island"
