At the Particular Request of Christopher Blank I have Resurveyed and Examined his land this 5th. May 1790 and have Carefully laid his three draughts together situate in Whitehall Township Northampton County & I do Certify that the above two described tracts viz one of them Surveyed to Michael Hallacher on a Warrant dated the 21st February 1754 containing 70a. 25p. & 120 perches and the other Surveyed to said Hallacher on a Warrant dated the 11-January 1759, are Situate Exactly as they are above described - Altho Christopher Blank Obtained a Patent for 111a. 150p. the 30th. Sepr. 1788 in which those two tracts are joined together. Given under my Hand the day and Year abovesaid.
