The above is a Draught of a Survey made October 27th 1829, for Robert Henderson, situate in Straban Township, W. County, Containing two hundred and ninety eight Acres and four perches and Allowance of six pr Cent. being a part of a body of land called Morganza situate in the Forks of Chartiers Creek— The above Survey is composed of part of three Original Surveys. The Compartment marked A. is a part of a tract of land granted to Paul Fooks, in pursuance of an Application No. 1916. Dated April 3d. 1769. (for 288 Acres & 120 perches). Containing about 200 Acres, strict measure, The Compartment marked B. is a part of a tract of land granted to David Evans, in pursuance of an Application No. 1969. Dated April 3d. 1769. (for 201 Acres & 140 perches). Containing about 48 acres. The Compartment marked C. is a part of a tract of land granted to Robert Harrison, in pursuance of an Application No. 548, Dated April 3d. 1769. (for 275 Acres & 117 perches). Containing about 67 Acres, all situate on the West side of the Monongahela River. Note these old surveys which compose the Morganza tract, will over run Considerably.
