



Situate in Manheim Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 85a. & 77 perches and allowance, Being part of a larger Tract of Land, which was Originally Surveyed by Thomas Cookson deceased, In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Philip Heidleman for 100a. More or less bearing date the 10th day of November 1748. And afterwards, to wit, on the 3d. day of May A.D. 1775, the same was Resurveyed &c. by Archibald McClean late D.S. In Pursuance of an Order of Resurvey Granted to Henry Martin and George Peter Baum, bearing date the 17th day of April A.D. 1775. And now on the 2d. & 3d. days of February A.D. 1808. Resurveyed and Divided off as above from the said larger Tract of Land, Agreeably to the Old lines & Divisions at the Request of George Steffee alias George Stephen, present owner, who desired us to make Return of the Draught.
