



Draft: of a tract of land situate in South Middleton Twp. Cumberland county. Surveyed Jan. 1st. 1795. on a warrant dated Feb. 24th. 1794. Containing 268 as 118 pers & allowance. At a meeting of the Board of Property <sup>June</sup> 7th. 1859 a petition was presented by Stewart Mc Gowan representing an interference with prior office rights. Whereupon an order was issued to J. G. Eckels County Surveyor. Dated Dec. 3rd. 1868 to resurvey and exclude any interference by prior office rights and include any vacant or unappropriated land adjoining.

In pursuance of said order I re-surveyed said tract and exclude triangle A & C being included in the survey of Deardorff & Fickle as represented in the plot. and include triangle B. as vacant or unappropriated

March 24th. 1869.
