



Draft of tract of land in Hamilton township, McKean county, Pa., on waters of Chapel Fork, containing 58 acres and allowance of 6 per cent. Surveyed March 8th 1884. Returned April 9th 1884 in pursuance of Warrant to G. H. Lyon dated Jan. 16th 1884, and bounded as follows; to wit, On the north by Warrant 5556, on the east by Dist. line No. 5, on the south by warrant 5570, & on the west by Warrant 5573, or by Warrants 5571 & 5573. The same being a strip 13 1/2 rods wide and 530 rods long, and unimproved. Bearings refer to true meridian.
