Granted at the request of George Miller and James Pennel in order to ascertain and Confirm to them in Trust for the Minor Children of George Edge Deceased some overplus Land Supposed to be included in the above described Tract Granted by Patent in the Year 1690 unto a Certain James Swaffer in Fee from the Commissioners of Property said to contain 500as Situate in the Township of upper Providence in Chester County. I have carefully Surveyed and Examined the above said Tract by the Antient bounds thereof and Do find the whole to contain 635as beside the allowance of Six p Cent. I have also Surveyed that part of the said Tract which belongs to the Heirs of George Edge aforesaid which I find to contain 344 as beside the Allowance of Six p Cent. Including the Dower or third of Mary the Widow of John Edge as in and by the above Draught is set forth and Described
