A. D. 1771 for 120<sup>as</sup> Granted to John Johnston and contains 147<sup>as</sup> 124<sup>ps</sup> and allowance

The above part surveyd for Peter Hench the present owner and occupier the 21<sup>st</sup> of May Anno Domini 1822

John Johnston's 2 Warr<sup>ts</sup> 1 of 30 Nov. 1766 the other of 6 Nov. 1771 appears to have been laid on the whole bounds above without designating the one from the other. Benjamin Junkins and Adam Junkins holders under Johnston made a division as appears along the South side of of the run which I have adopted as the division between said warrants laying the 1<sup>st</sup> one South of the run as it calls for; and the last one adjoining it as it requires. Appearing as agreeable to the terms of said warrants as any that could be fix<sup>d</sup> on - unless the Board otherwise direct.
