

Situate in the River Susquehanna, in the Township of Canestogoe and County of Lancaster, Surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrent dated the tenth day of November 1803 granted to John Kindiq and Philip Urban, the Courses and distances are as follows Viz!: Beginning at this Mark in the above diagram, thence South Eighty one degrees East fourteen perches, thence down the River South fifteen degrees East ten perches, North eighty one degrees West fourteen perches, thence up s! River North fifteen degrees West ten perches to the Place of Beginning Containing three quarters of an acre of Land & allowance of six pr C! "Caled Willow Island" being—Between Eshleman's Falls and Canastogoe Island and about two-and fifty yards below an Island (said) Improved by George + Prime Lewis Urban & Israel Nestelroth—Nov! 15th 1803
